It was a beautiful day and all of our guests (two legged and four legged) enjoyed the venue at Fiore Winery. There was music by the band Five Old Guys (FOG) and a full buffet of heavy Hors d'oeuvres. We had caricatures of the pups by our own in house artist Mary Booth. Danielle our groomer had a booth with people and dog accessories for her charity "A Chance for Life" (read more below). A representative from the Cookie Lee jewelry company had a display of jewelry to help all the men in attendance get ready for Mothers Day . The large lawns at Fiore were covered in rainbow umbrella and tents for shade. The pups enjoyed their special treats of gourmet cookies and all had a wonderful afternoon for exceptional charities. A Chance For Life

This a charity named after a dog that Danielle rescued from last year's Bark and Wine event. Chance had severe injuries from having been dropped repeatedly by the former owner's children. As a result the only way that he might be able to recover and walk on his own would require a \$7800 surgery. Danielle believed that this dog deserved a chance, hence his name. So many owners are faced with the heart breaking decision of exorbitant medical expenses or euthanasia for their best friend. Pet E.R.'s make this decision even more difficult in that they will not allow an owner to go on a payment plan. Danielle's mission is to help owners of dogs with catastrophic injuries or illnesses fund the medical expenses. When successful, this fund will help owners save their best friend and not have to make that life or death decision due to a monetary issue.
