Welcome Back! Lobby Reopening

- Best Friends Fur Ever lobbies are open from 6:15am 8:45am (morning drop-off/pick-up), 12:30pm 1:45pm (mid-day drop-off & pick-up) and 5pm 6:30pm (evening pick-up). In addition, Cockeysville will be open for late pick-ups and early drop-offs if the client has noted this request in their reservation.
- We will be allowing a maximum of four clients at a time in our lobbies.
- All clients are required to wear a mask while on our premises and in our lobbies.
- All clients must follow the lobby signs and practice a minimum of 6 feet social distance while on our premises and in our lobbies.
- Please no gathering and congregating in groups either in the parking lots or lobbies.
- Clients will be checked in as they enter the building and asked to

proceed to the appropriate socially distanced circle to await assistance.

- Once the handler has control of the dog on a lead, we ask all clients verify with the front desk that they have been appropriately checked in and exit the building to allow for other clients to enter the building.
- We will continue to offer contact-less pick-up and drop-off in our parking lot for clients that request this service. To request this service, clients should call the facility upon arrival and a handler will be out as soon as available to assist.
- We ask clients that are boarding or new to us to print off and fill out the required paperwork for their upcoming visit at home. If a client is unable to complete this paperwork before arrival, we will provide the appropriate paperwork and ask the client to either complete the forms outside or in their car as this will allow us to continue to assist other clients.
- We will have hand sanitizer readily available for your convenience.
- All grooming clients can pick-up once their dog is done. We will bring groomed dogs to the lobby entrance for pick-up and collect payment at time of completion.
