



# Cockeysville Pet Parents,

We have been made aware of an upper respiratory infection currently present in the area, including guests that have visited our resort. The respiratory virus appears to be very mild - only lasting 3 to 4 days and has no serious impact on the pup. The symptoms of the virus include coughing and discharge from the eyes and nose.

This virus is very similar to the common cold that humans experience. Just like kids going to school and adults going to work, sometimes a cold gets passed around. No serious illness has been reported to us other than the pup coughing and experiencing a runny nose or eyes, and the cases reported to us have noted the pup is fully recovered within 3 to 4 days.

If your pup is experiencing any of these symptoms, please do not bring them to our resorts or let them near other dogs, as they are likely contagious. Consult your vet if your pup has symptoms.

If you choose to continue bringing your pup to our facility during this time, please be mindful that if we notice any symptoms, according to our procedures, you will be asked to pick them up immediately.
