Risks of Matted Coats in Pets

Matted fur can hide a variety of issues and create discomfort or health risks for your pet. Here are the potential risks:

- Skin Irritation: Matted fur can cause redness, swelling, irritation, or cracked skin, which may not be visible until the mats are removed.
- Hidden Pests: Mats can conceal fleas and other parasites.
- Obscured Skin Conditions: Mats can hide moles, scabs, or other skin issues. This increases the risk that a groomer may accidentally nick, cut, or damage the skin during grooming.
- Aggravated Skin: Removing mats can further irritate the skin.
- Additional Reactions: Pets may develop hot spots, sensitive areas, or aural hematomas (especially if mats were near the ears).

Grooming & Matted Pet Release

Shaving is sometimes necessary to remove mats or improve coat maintenance. While we take every precaution, shaving does carry risks and requires post-grooming care to support healthy regrowth.

Risks of Shaving a Pet

- Uneven or Patchy Regrowth: The coat may not grow back evenly or in the same color.
- Temperature Sensitivity: Without their full coat, pets are more vulnerable to heat or cold.
- Behavioral Changes: Some pets may feel self-conscious and behave differently after shaving.
- Revealed Skin Conditions: Pre-existing skin issues may only become visible after shaving.
- Slower Regrowth in Some Pets: Pets with certain medical conditions may regrow hair more slowly or not at all.

Caring for a Recently Shaved Pet

Proper care is essential to support coat regrowth and protect your pet:

- Brush Weekly: Regular brushing helps prevent new matting and supports healthy regrowth.
- Bathe Regularly: Clean skin and fur promote better regrowth.
- Sun Protection: Keep shaved pets out of direct sunlight. Apply pet-safe sunscreen if needed.

Important Note on Matted Pets

If mats are present, brushing them out may not be possible without causing discomfort. In such cases, shaving the matted areas—or the entire coat—may be necessary. This comes with the same risks and maintenance needs listed above.
