



VACCINES REQUIRED FOR BFFE



In addition to vaccines, we also require all dogs to be on year-round flea & tick prevention and heartworm & parasite prevention.

RABIES REQUIRED

**BY 16 WEEKS OF AGE
(REQUIRED BY LAW)**

VACCINES COMPLETED 7 DAYS BEFORE STAY (Puppies, First Time or Lapsed Vaccinations)



DHPP

MULTI-DOSE

Dogs require a series of boosters.



BORDETELLA (CIRDC / KENNEL COUGH)

INTRANASAL OR ORAL:

Single dose
(not multi-dose)

INJECTABLE:

Multi-dose
(2 doses spaced
2-4 weeks apart)

MULTI-DOSE

Dogs require a series of boosters.

MULTI-DOSE

Dogs require a series of boosters.



RABIES

For puppies under 16 weeks:
Rabies vaccine is NOT required.

For dogs 16 weeks and older:
Valid proof of Rabies
vaccination is mandatory.

VACCINE MAINTENANCE (FOR ONGOING CARE)



DHPP

Protects against distemper, hepatitis, parvovirus, and parainfluenza.

Booster every 3 years



BORDETELLA (CIRDC / KENNEL COUGH)

Protects against canine infectious respiratory disease (kennel cough).

Booster every 6-12 months



LEPTOSPIROSIS

Protects against leptospirosis, a bacterial infection that can affect people and pets.

Booster every year
If you miss your annual booster, your veterinarian will restart the initial series. (2 doses spread 3 to 4 weeks apart)



CANINE INFLUENZA

Protects against canine influenza (dog flu).

Booster every year
If you miss your annual booster, your veterinarian will restart the initial series. (2 doses spread 2 to 3 weeks apart)



RABIES

Protects against rabies.

Booster every 1-3 years (per MD law & vaccine type)

PARASITE PREVENTION

Must be given year-round and kept up to date.



VACCINE RECORDS MUST BE:

- ✓ Up to date
- ✓ Legible
- ✓ From a licensed veterinarian
